# Native American/Native Hawaiian Museum Services Program

<b>Program Goal</b>	To enhance museum services to sustain heritage, culture, and knowledge among Indian tribes and organizations serving Native Hawaiians
<b>Duration</b>	1-2 years
<b>Funding Levels</b>	\$5,000-\$100,000
<b>Cost Share</b>	None required
<b>Deadline</b>	November 15, 2021



# Native American/Native Hawaiian Museum Services Program - Goals

- **Goal 1:** Empower people of all ages and backgrounds through experiential and cross-disciplinary learning and discovery.
  - Objective 1.1: Support public programs, adult programs, family programs, and early childhood programs.
  - Objective 1.2: Support exhibitions, interpretation, and digital media.
  - Objective 1.3: Support in-school and out-of-school programs.
  - Objective 1.4: Support the growth and development of Native American and Native Hawaiian museum professionals.





# Native American/Native Hawaiian Museum Services Program - Goals

- **Goal 2:** Build the capacity of Indian tribes and organizations that primarily serve and represent Native Hawaiians to work more effectively.
  - Objective 2.1: Support institutional planning and policy development.
  - Objective 2.2: Support technology enhancements.



# Native American/Native Hawaiian Museum Services Program - Goals

- **Goal 3:** Advance the management and care of Native American and Native Hawaiian collections and their associated documentation.
  - Objective 3.1: Support cataloging, inventorying, and registration; collections information management; and collections planning.
  - Objective 3.2: Support conservation and environmental improvement and/or rehousing; conservation survey; and conservation treatment.
  - Objective 3.3: Support database management, digital asset management, and digitization.
  - Objective 3.4: Support the preservation and perpetuation of indigenous languages and traditional cultural practices.

# Native American Library Services: Basic Grants



Designed to assist Native American tribes in improving core library services for their communities.

**Goal 1:** Improve services for learning and accessing information in a variety of formats to support needs for education, workforce development, economic and business development, health information, critical thinking skills, digital literacy skills, and financial literacy and other types of literacy skills.

**Goal 2:** Enhance the skills of the current library workforce and leadership through training, continuing education, and opportunities for professional development.



# Native American Library Services: Basic Grants

<b>Amount and Length:</b>	\$6,000 - \$10,000 (up to \$3,000 for professional development/assessment activities) – 1 Year
<b>Deadline:</b>	March 1, 2022 11:59 PM EST
<b>Cost Share:</b>	Not required
<b>Eligibility:</b>	Federally recognized tribes; Alaska Native villages and corporations
<b>Award Decisions (Anticipated)</b>	July 2022
<b>Period of Performance</b>	Aug 1, 2022 – July 31, 2023

# Native American Library Services: Enhancement Grants



Designed to assist Native American tribes in improving core library services for their communities.

**Goal 1:** Improve **digital services** to support needs for education, workforce development, economic and business development, health information, critical thinking skills, and digital literacy skills.

**Goal 2:** Improve **educational programs** related to specific topics and content areas of interest to library patrons and community-based users.

**Goal 3:** Enhance the **preservation** and revitalization of Native American cultures and languages.



# Native American Library Services: Enhancement Grants

**Amount and Length:** \$10,000 - \$150,000 (2 Years)

**Deadline:** April 1, 2022 11:59 PM EST

**Cost Share:** Not required

**Eligibility:** Federally recognized tribes; Alaska Native villages and corporations

**Award Decisions  
(Anticipated)** August 2022

**Period of  
Performance** Sep 1, 2022 – Aug 30, 2024
